

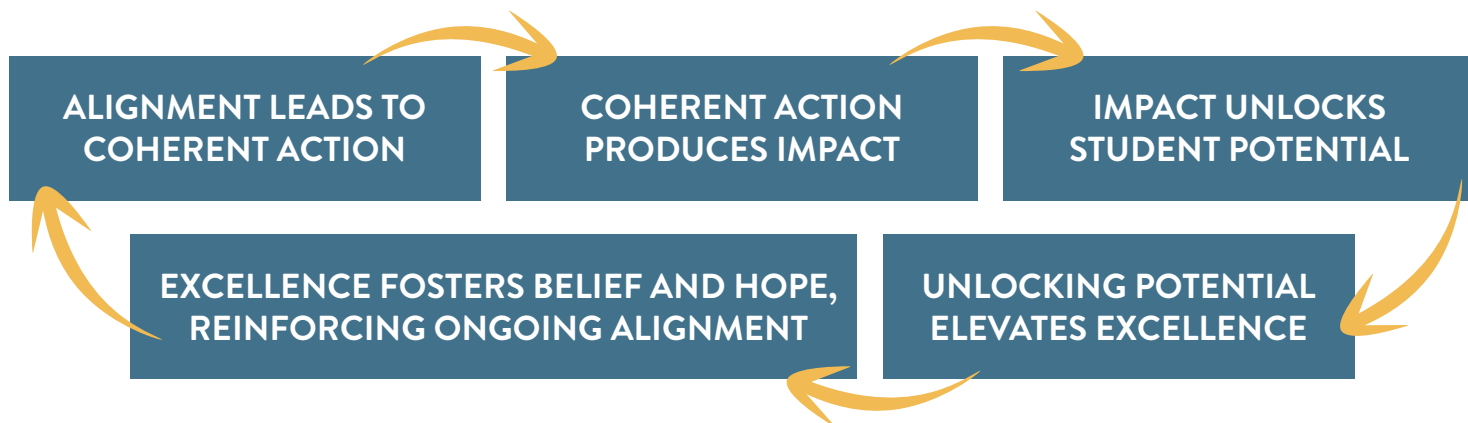

CHARACTER & RESILIENCY EDUCATION & STUDENT WELLNESS

Character & Resiliency Education (CARE) & Student Wellness sessions equip attendees with practical strategies to build character, resilience, and healthy habits that support both academic and personal growth. The focus is on helping students develop integrity, perseverance, and balance—skills that strengthen engagement, motivation, and long-term success.

CIVICS

Exhibit Booth Space

Standard Booth Furnishings:

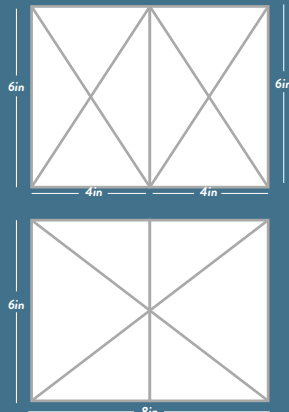

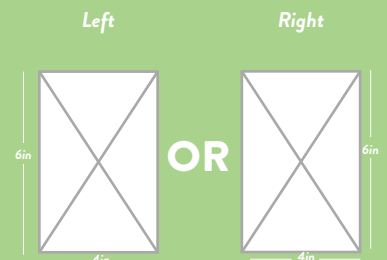
